Lessons Learned



- **Important to have vertical team involved early, especially in uncharted territory**

- **Value of face to face meetings and site visits to reach level of understanding and consensus**

- **Keep ITR comments focused on technical issues, address editorial comments separately**

- **Document needs to be clear**
 - **Nomenclature should not be confusing**
 - **Presentation in document should be clear and concise**

Lessons Learned

- **Early and continual vertical team involvement is key when dealing with new policy issues (e.g., reconstruction authority)**
- **Vertical team site visit and interaction with project sponsor increased the level of understanding of the area's problems/opportunities**
