MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDER, North Atlantic Division (CENAD-PD)

SUBJECT: Implementation Guidance for Section 4013(a) of the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 (WRRDA 2014) – Technical Corrections, Raritan River

1. Section 4013(a) of Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 (Pub. L. 113-121) repealed Section 102 of the Energy and Water Development Appropriations Act of 1998 (P. L. 105-62; 111 Stat. 1327). The repeal removes a prohibition on the use of appropriated funds to construct the Oak Way and the Sky Top detention structures in Berkeley Heights, New Jersey, as part of the project for flood control, Green Brook Sub-Basin, Raritan River Basin, New Jersey, authorized by section 401(a) of the Water Resources Development Act of 1986.

2. At such time that funds become available, a general reevaluation report will be prepared in accordance with current planning and policy guidance and procedures in order to determine whether or not these features of the authorized plan are technically sound, environmentally acceptable, and economically justified. Funding for this study may be considered in accordance with existing budgetary policy and guidance.

WRRDA 2014. SEC. 4013. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS

(a) RARITAN RIVER.—Section 102 of the Energy and Water Development Appropriations Act, 1998 (Public Law 105–62; 111 Stat. 1327), is repealed.
