MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDER, Great Lakes and Ohio River Division

SUBJECT: Implementation Guidance for Section 6004(a)(18) of the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 (WRRDA 2014) – Manitowoc Harbor, Wisconsin

1. Section 6004(a)(18) of WRRDA 2014 modifies the Manitowoc River, Manitowoc, Wisconsin, navigation project authorized by the Act of August 30, 1852 (10 Stat. 58; chapter 104, as amended) by deauthorizing a portion of the Federal channel in Manitowoc Harbor. The triangular area deauthorized is approximately 3,600 square feet (0.083 acre) and delineated by the following coordinates: 44.09893383N and 087.66854912W; 44.09900535N and 087.66864372W; and 44.09857884N and 087.66913123W. A copy of Section 6004(a)(18) is enclosed.
2. The district should send a survey map showing the revised channel limits and coordinates of the Manitowoc Harbor, Wisconsin, project to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Office of Coast Survey and the U.S. Coast Guard so that changes can be reflected on NOAA's nautical charts and the aids to navigation can be repositioned accordingly.

SUBJECT: Implementation Guidance for Section 6004(a)(18) of the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 – Manitowoc Harbor, Wisconsin

Section 6004(a)(18) MANITOWOC HARBOR, WISCONSIN.—The portion of the project for navigation, Manitowoc River, Manitowoc, Wisconsin, authorized by the Act of August 30, 1852 (10 Stat. 58; chapter 104), and described as follows is no longer authorized beginning on the date of enactment of this Act: The triangular area bound by—

- (A) 44.09893383N and 087.66854912W;
- (B) 44.09900535N and 087.66864372W; and
- (C) 44.09857884N and 087.66913123W
