

Records Freeze

The moratorium on Corps of Engineers Environmental Restoration Records remains in effect. Request that you add all tobacco related records to the following Army "Records Freezes" listed below that are current and ongoing:

- a. Bosnia and Somalia
- b. Chemical and Biological Warfare (freeze code CBW)
- c. E.I. du Pont De Nemours and Company (DuPont, Sporting Goods Properties, Inc (formerly known and incorporated as Remington Arms Company, Inc.)(Remington) and Conoco, Inc. (Conoco).
- d. Iranian Foreign Military Sales (freeze code IRA).
- e. Merger of Lockheed Martin Corporation and the Northrop Grumman Corporation.
- f. U.S. v. Shell Oil Company, Rocky Mountain Arsenal.
- g. Werlein v. U.S. and New Brighton v. U.S. (freeze code TCA)
- h. Rocky Mountain Arsenal Employees Exposure to Nerve Agents (freeze code RMA)
- i. Twin Cities Army Ammunition Plant Environmental Problem (freeze code TCA)
- j. Freeze All Army Records Referencing Tobacco

All Army activities will cease destroying any and all related records listed above until notified to resume regular disposition schedule.
