SUBJECT: Repeal of Requirement to Submit Privacy Act Report

1. Reference E-mail message from Department of the Army, dated 22 Jan 01, SAB.
2. Congress has repealed the requirement for submission of a biennial Privacy Act (PA) Report. We are no longer required to collect data relating to how many PA access/amendment requests were processed. However, please be advised that the "reviews" as mandated by OMB Circular A-130, paragraph 3a of Appendix I, are still required. The information should be collected and maintained locally.
