



- Develops and conducts education programs in the form of workshops, seminars, short courses, counseling sessions, etc. to expand the use of flood proofing and nonstructural flood damage reduction techniques at all levels of government and in the private sector.
- Documents flood proofing activities and disseminates flood proofing publications.
- Promotes flood proofing throughout the Nation through the development of a comprehensive flood plain management plan.
