MEMORANDUM FOR Commander, Huntsville Division

SUBJECT: Chemical Demilitarization Life Cycle Project Management
(LCPM) Assignment

1. You are appointed the USACE Life Cycle Project Manager for Chemical Demilitarization and, as such, are responsible for the Corps of Engineers (CE) involvement in the Chemical Demilitarization Program. A Program Management Plan is required which embodies LCPM principles and which coordinates the CE LCPM system with the management strategies being used by the Program Manager for Chemical Demilitarization (PMCD). You shall follow the Draft LCPM guidance issued by this headquarters to the maximum extent possible. HQUSACE Military Programs Directorate will provide oversight of this program and Project Management Division (CEMP-M) will serve as your primary point of contact.
2. Program Review Boards (PRB) meetings shall commence not later than 1 May 1990, and LCPM data collection and reporting shall begin immediately. You will chair a CE Executive Review Group which is to meet at least quarterly. The divisions will be notified by a copy of this letter, and you will define their roles and responsibilities in a Program Management Plan (PMP). The PMP shall clearly show that Huntsville Division is responsible for the scope, budget, schedule, quality, and customer interface for the portion of this program assigned to the CE. The Program Management Plan is to be approved by the Director of Military Programs and PMCD.
3. This appointment is effective immediately and shall remain in effect as long as the requirement for CE support to PMCD exists. This letter supersedes the Corps Program Execution Agent (PEA) letter dated 24 September 1987.
