SUBJECT: Corps-wide Areas of Work Responsibility


1. References:

2. Reference 1.b., requires you, as a Major Subordinate Command (MSC), to obtain written approval of the USACE activity in whose geographic MSC or functional (laboratory/field operating activity) area the work is located, regardless of your programmatic and functional boundaries, unless established as a Mandatory Center of Expertise Program (reference 1.c.) or specifically approved by the Commander, USACE. I am exempting work assignments provided to you in the reorganization of the Center for Public Works and work assignments from programs directed by higher authority prior to 1 Oct 97 that are in your mission area.

3. It appears that, in accordance with your enclosure 3 to reference 1.a., one work assignment requires consideration for brokering, i.e., the Maintenance, Repair and Renewal program. If brokering efforts are not successful, please submit this work requirement through the Director of Military Programs to the USACE Board of Directors (BOD), attention CEDC, in the format required by reference 1.b.
