SUBJECT: PARC Instruction 93-2, Source Selection

2. The purpose of this Instruction Letter is to provide guidance to Corps activities involved in source selection. It is not intended as a substitute for policy cited in the references, particularly AFARS appendix AA. Provisions in the manual shall be used in competitively negotiated procurements except for the procurement of A-E services.


