MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Interim Guidance for the Placement of Departmental Publications
and Forms on the Internet/World Wide Web (WWW)


As the proponent for AR 25-30 (The Army Integrated Publishing and Printing Program), I must ensure that only official, authenticated publications and forms are distributed via approved distribution media. Approved distribution media for publications and forms are paper, microfiche, CD-ROM, and the Internet/WWW.

To prevent potential litigation risks to Army and eliminate redundant publishing efforts, the web sites at the enclosure are designated as official web sites for departmental publications and forms. The web site of each organization listed is the official repository for departmental publications and blank forms. Copies of departmental publications and blank forms on other web sites are not considered accurate, current, or official versions and must not be used. Therefore, those web sites wishing to give access to departmental publications and forms must establish electronic links to the appropriate web site (see enclosure).

Agency and command web sites may contain official authenticated agency and command publications and forms. Also, these agencies and commands may staff draft publications and forms on the Internet/WWW if the access is limited to those activities involved in staffing the publication or form. All pages must be earmarked as "draft."

This guidance will help ensure only unrestricted distribution, unclassified, and authenticated publications and forms are available on the Internet/WWW. In addition, this policy ensures that users in the field can rely on these designated web sites to ensure they have access to the current and accurate version of the official publication.

Official policy is currently being staffed and will be published during the 3d Quarter 1998 timeframe.
