




- Assessment improve data collection and sexual assault reporting capability





*DOD civilian employees restricted reporting and SAPR service is approved for a 1-year trial period, with the following provisions: (1) comply with collective bargaining obligations, as applicable. (2) DOD civilian in the CONUS & OCONUS will have both options of restricted & unrestricted reporting effective 5 Jan 2017. This change is rescinded at the end of the 1-year trial period.
