Key Messages for Tropical Storm Beryl

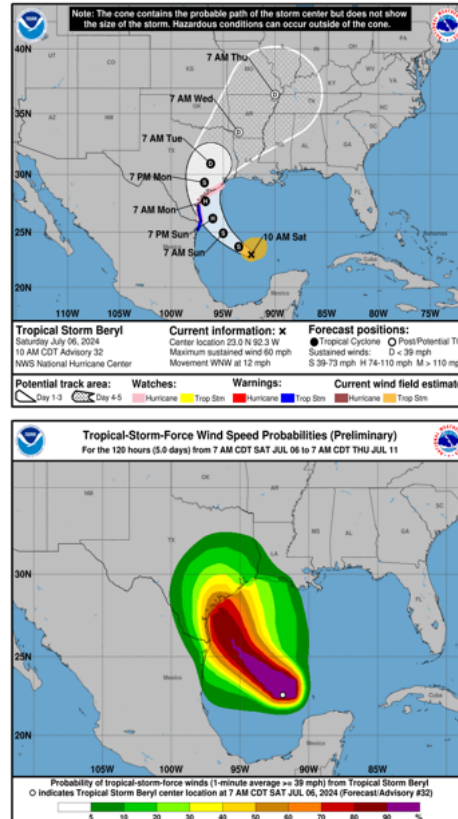

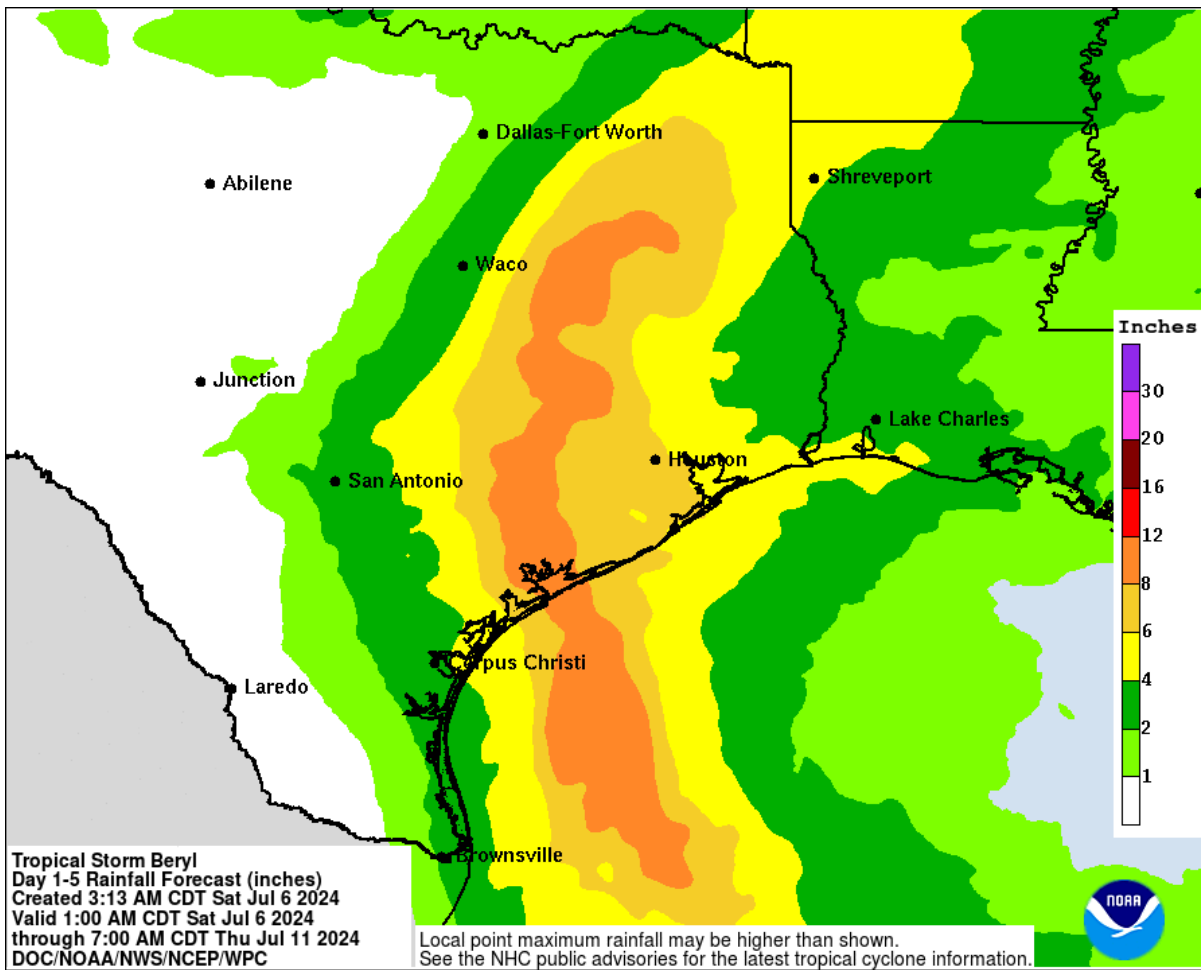
1. There is an increasing risk of damaging hurricane-force winds and life-threatening storm surge along portions of the lower and middle Texas coast late Sunday into Monday, where Hurricane and Storm Surge Watches are in effect. A Tropical Storm Warning is now in effect for portions of deep south Texas and additional warnings will likely be required later today. Interests in these areas should follow any advice given by local officials.

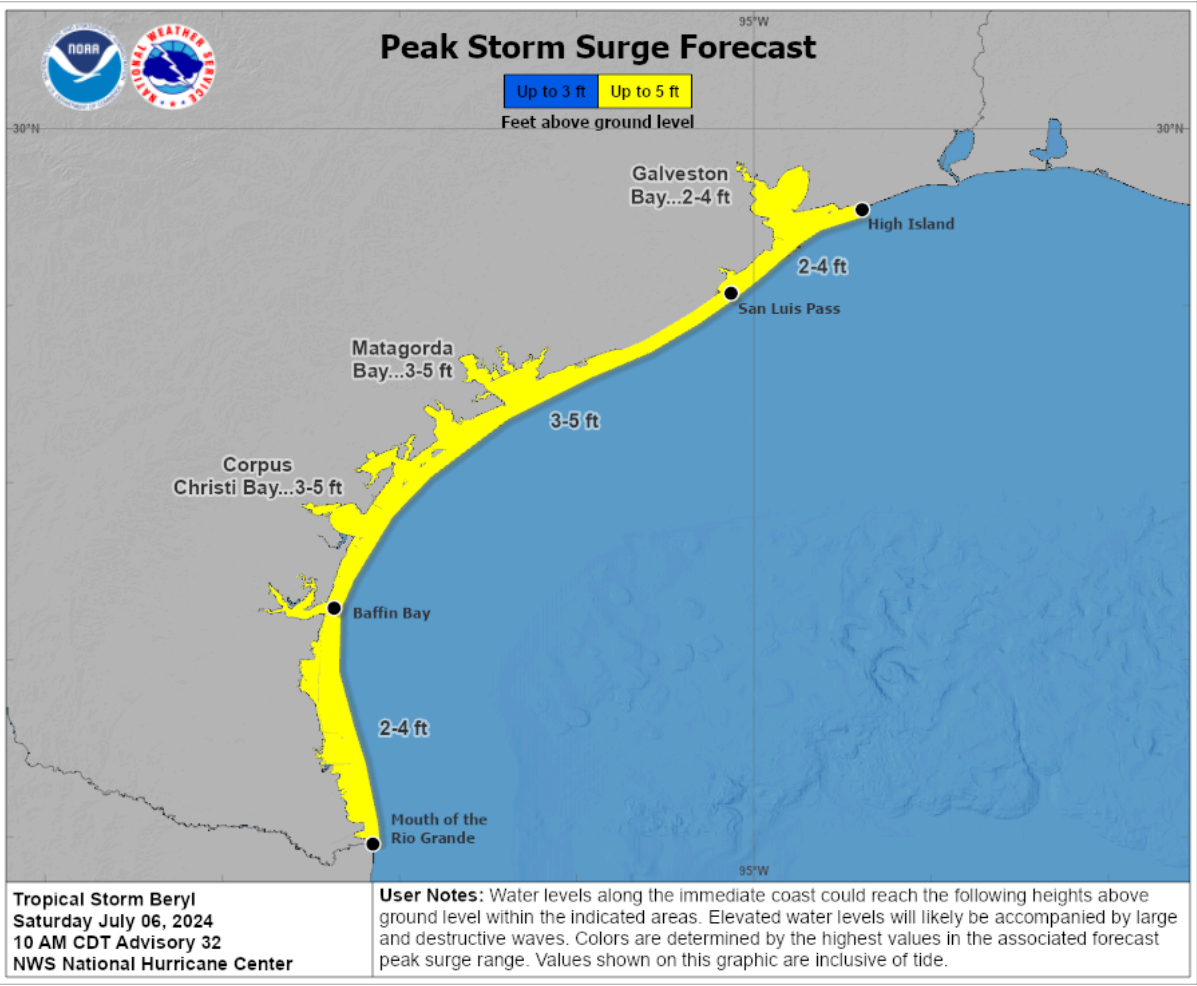
2. Flash and urban flooding, some of which may be locally considerable, is likely across portions of the Texas Gulf Coast and eastern Texas beginning late Sunday through the middle of next week.

3. Rip currents will cause life-threatening beach conditions through the weekend across much of the Gulf Coast. Beachgoers should heed warning flags and the advice of lifeguards and local officials before venturing into the water.

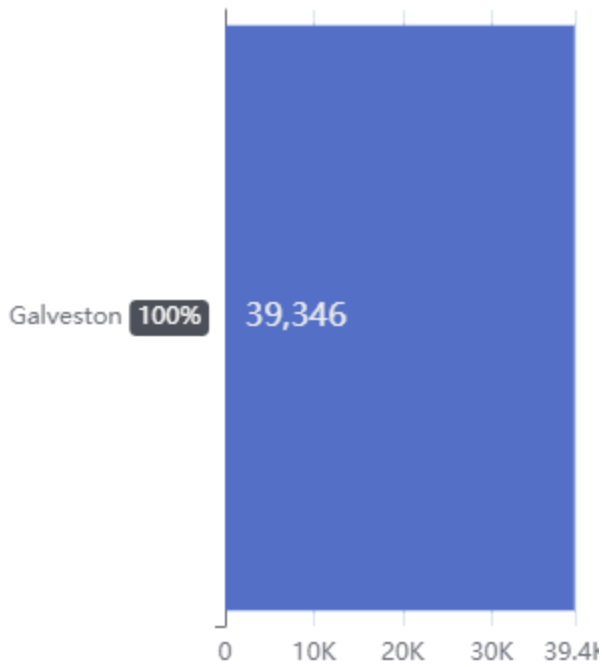

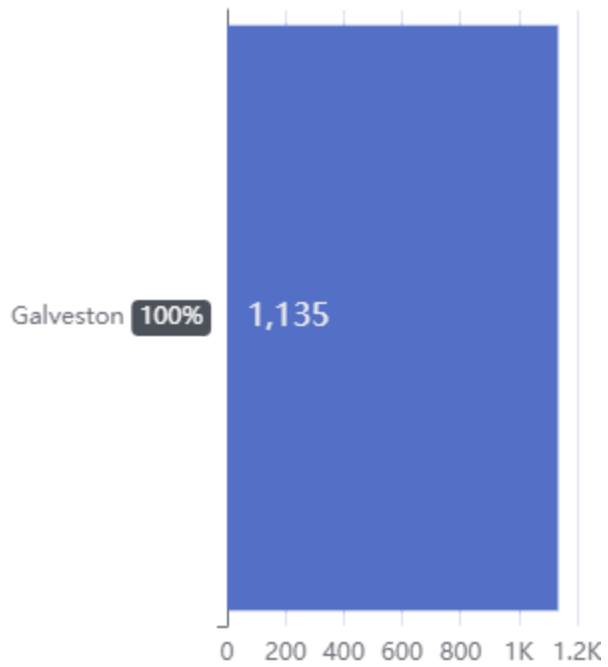

Total Debris By USACE District



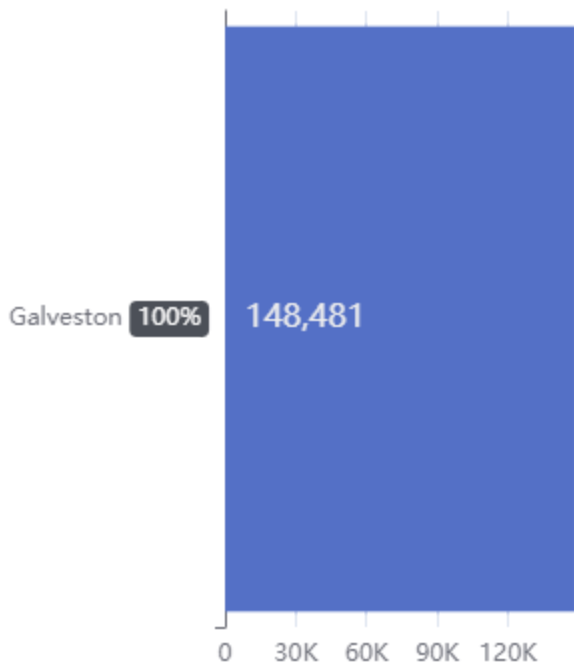

Total Estimated Roofing By USACE District



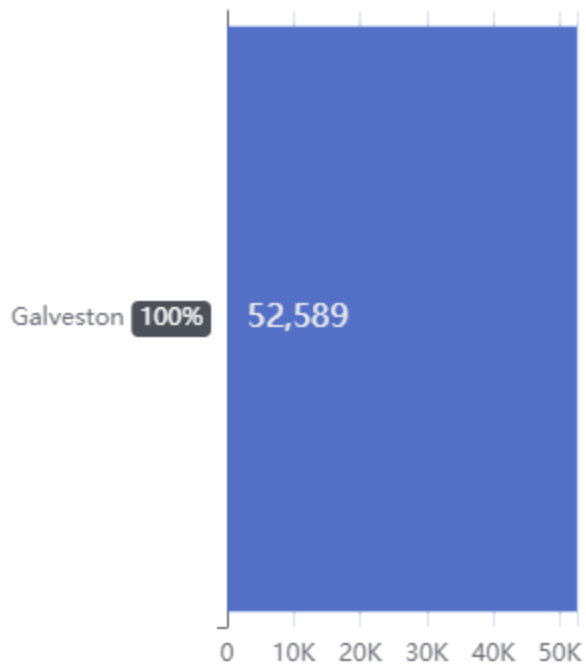

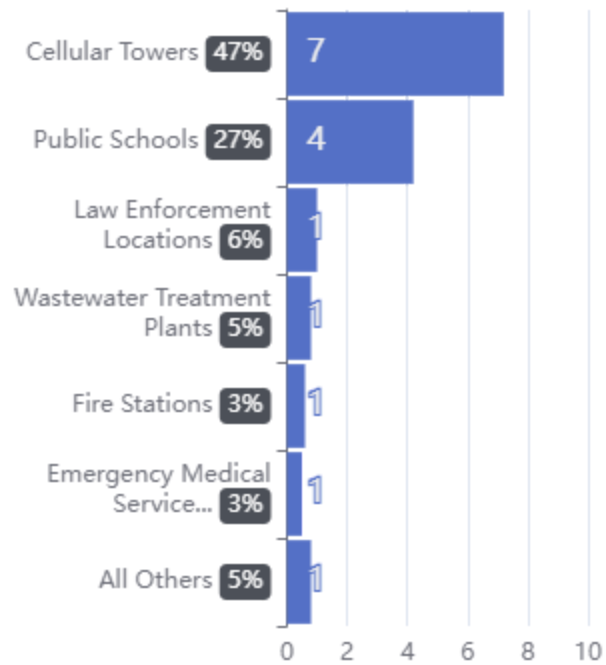

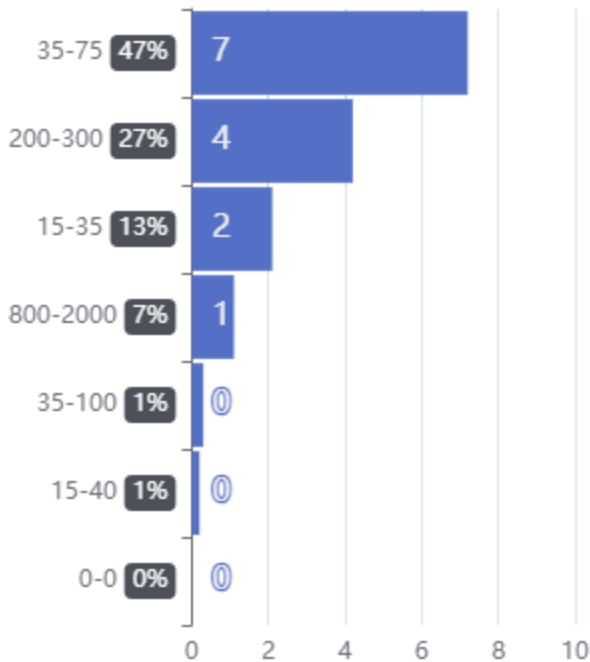
Generators

By Generator Count



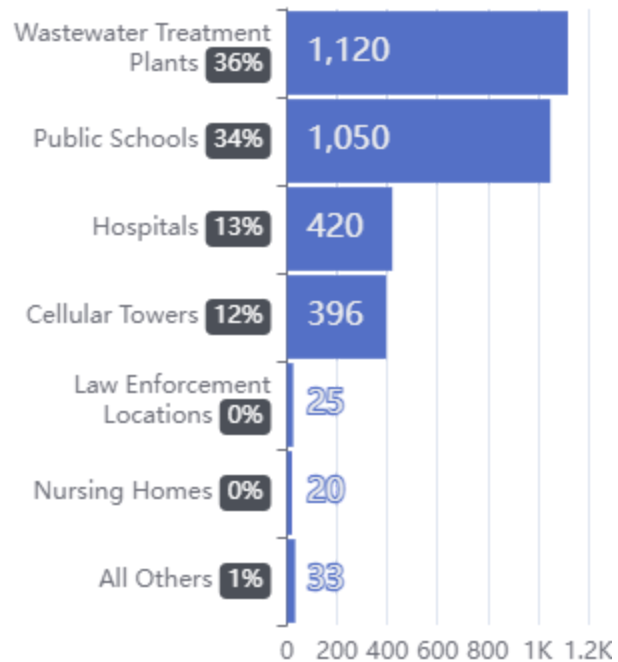

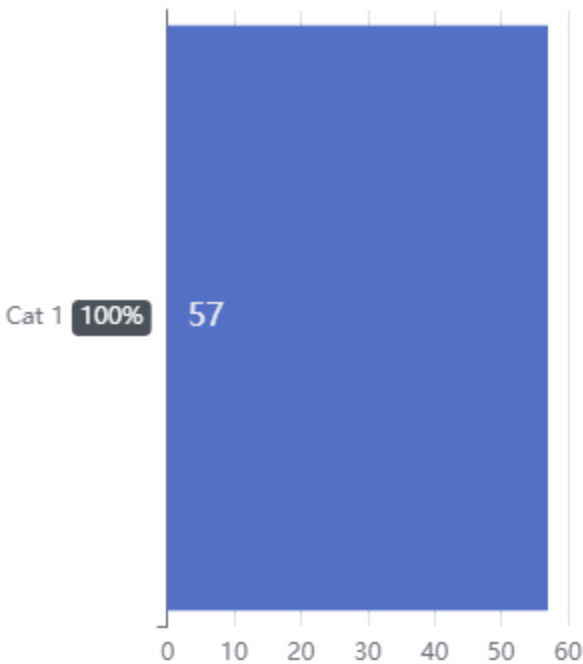

By Power Requirement (KW)



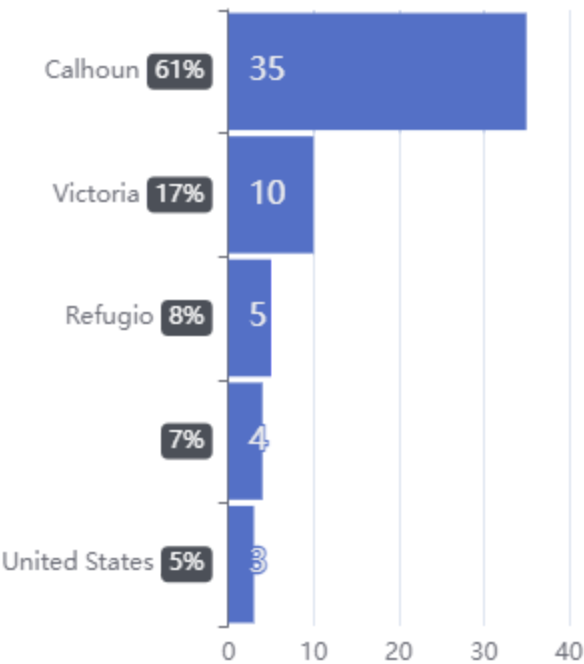

Total Estimated Roofing by County



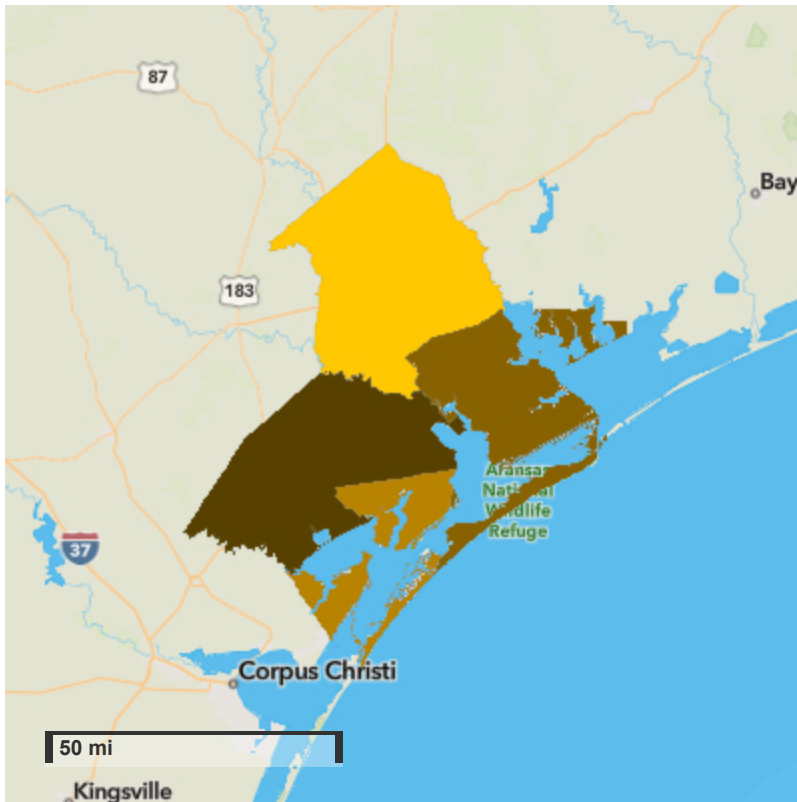
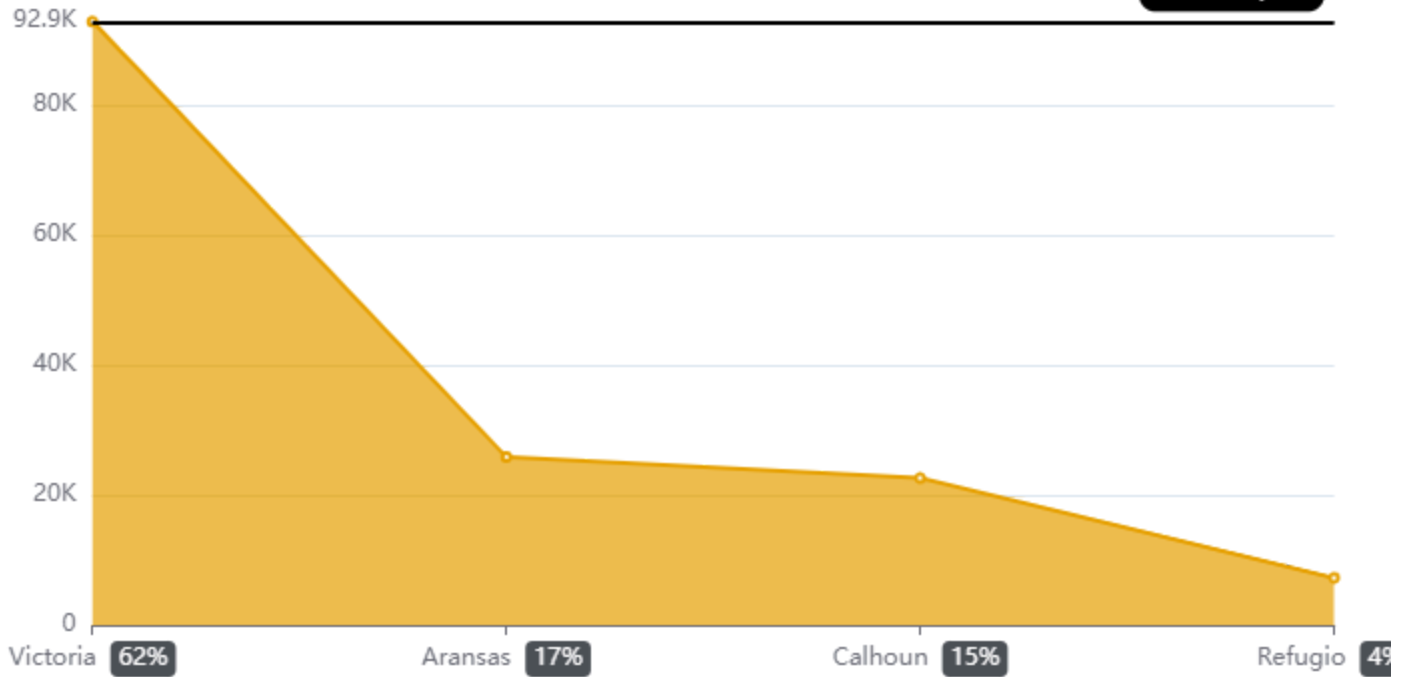

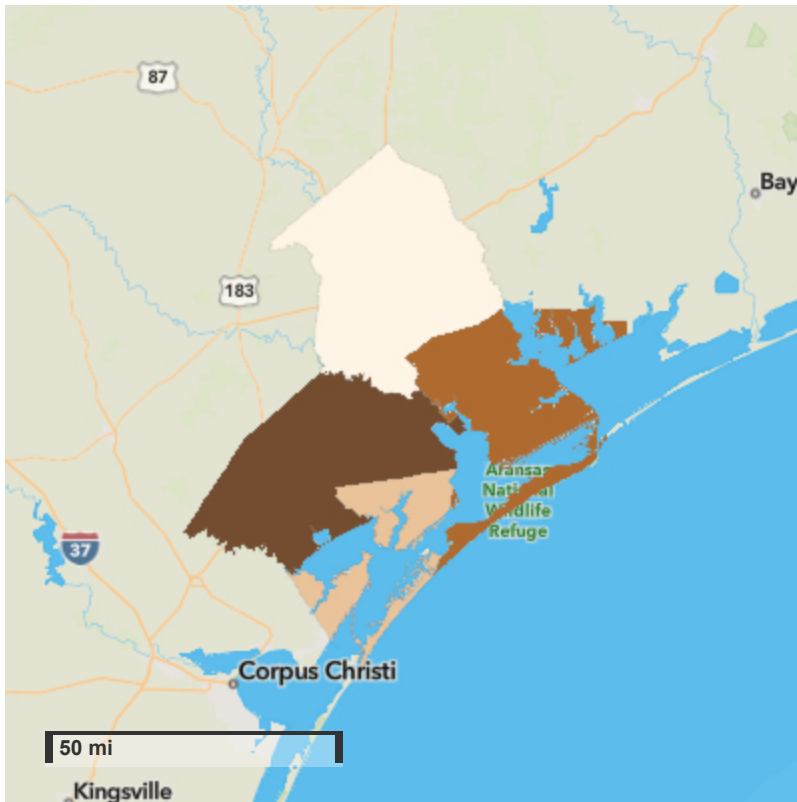
