





Key Messages for Tropical Storm Beryl Advisory 33: 4:00 PM CDT Sat Jul 06, 2024





- 1. There is a danger of life-threatening storm surge inundation late Sunday night and Monday along the coast of Texas from the north entrance to the Padre Island National Seashore to San Luis Pass. Residents in that area should follow any advice given by local officials and follow evacuation orders.
- Beryl is forecast to bring damaging hurricane-force winds to portions of the lower and middle Texas coast late Sunday night and Monday. A Hurricane Warning is now in place from Baffin Bay to Sargent. Preparations should be rushed to completion before tropical storm conditions begin late Sunday.
- 3. Flash and urban flooding, some of which may be locally considerable, is likely across portions of the Texas Gulf Coast and eastern Texas beginning late Sunday through the middle of next week. River flooding is also possible.
- 4. Rip currents will cause life-threatening beach conditions through the weekend across much of the Gulf Coast. Beachgoers should heed warning flags and the advice of lifeguards and local officials before venturing into the water.





Mission Model Summary




Critical Infrastructure Summary




Generators

By Generator Count




Generators

By Range




Generators

By Power Requirement (KW)














Estimated Temporary Roofing



Total Estimated Roofing by County




