**MEMORANDUM FOR CHIEF OF ENGINEERS AND COMMANDER, US ARMY
CORPS OF ENGINEERS, 441 G STREET, NW, WASHINGTON, DC 20314-1000**

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority

- 1. The Army's Value Engineering (VE) program is managed by ASA(ALT) as part of its acquisition policy responsibilities under General Order 2002-03. By memorandum dated April 19, 2004, ASA(ALT) delegated certain Army VE responsibilities to the Commander, U.S. Army Materiel Command (AMC). These responsibilities were further delegated to the AMC Deputy Chief of Staff for Business Transformation.**
- 2. Under General Order 2002-03, The Chief of Engineers (COE) has Army Staff responsibilities for the formulation, implementation, management, and evaluation of engineering, construction, real property, and technical policy for DA, and is responsible for establishing and maintaining a viable Value Engineering program per Public Law 104-106.**
- 3. The Army VE responsibilities as identified in the "Agency Requirements" in the President's Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-131 are hereby delegated to the Chief of Engineers and Commander, US Army Corps of Engineers for the responsibilities identified under General Order 2002-03, to be executed in concert with the Commander, U.S. Army Materiel Command (AMC). Re-delegation of this authority to subordinate commands is not permitted.**
- 4. This delegation shall remain in effect unless or until rescinded in writing.**
