MEMORANDUM FOR All MSC Value Engineering Program Managers/ District VEOs

SUBJECT: Change to Federal Requirement for Value Engineering (VE), Lower Threshold Limit

- 1. The current OMB Circular A131 states the Federal requirement for VE applies to all procurements that have costs greater that \$1 million, regardless of the number of phases/contracts, delivery method, or customer. The current revision to this circular is in the final stages before release, and adjusts the lower threshold to \$2M. - 2. In anticipation of the imminent release of this revision the USACE policy is being revised to reflect the new lower threshold limit of \$2M. This shall serve as the interim policy until the release of the new ER 11-1-321 occurs later in FY13.
